This month we have learnt about Mary Seacole, Pele, Zaha Hadid & King Charles.

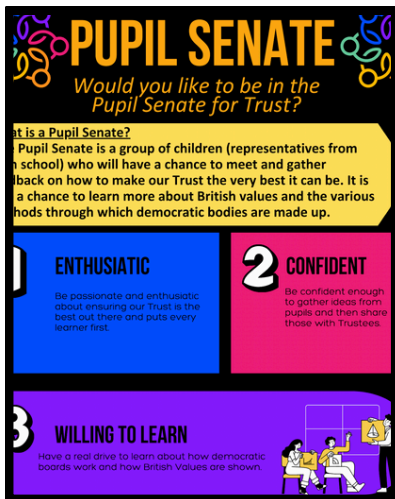
