Wellbeing: A Foundation for Success

The emotional and social well-being of pupils remains a priority, with each school refining its approach based on last year's outcomes:

- Rayleigh Primary continues to strengthen emotional regulation and social skills programs.
- North Crescent Primary deepens its trauma-informed pastoral care.
- Wyburns Primary enhances its Zones of Regulation framework, ensuring pupils are emotionally ready to learn.

This aligns with the Trust's ethical commitment to "fostering belonging and security"—a principle that underpins all our work.

Innovative, Targeted Interventions

The 2024-25 reports highlighted the impact of small-group tutoring, phonics mastery, and diagnostic assessments. In 2025-26, we are:

- Expanding evidence-based strategies (e.g., structured literacy interventions).
