CEO's Analysis of Key Stage 2 Performance Data 2023/2024 compared to 2024/25 -with Essex and Local Comparisons

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Rayleigh Primary School

- Cohort Size: Increased from 60 (2023/24) to 64 (2024/25)
- Male Students: Increased from 41.7% (2023/24) to 46.9% (2024/25)
- SEN Support: Decreased from 11.7% (2023/24) to 10.9% (2024/25)
- Ethnicity (BME): Decreased from 11.7% (2023/24) to 9.4% (2024/25)
- Language (EAL): Increased from 3.3% (2023/24) to 6.3% (2024/25)

Attainment and Assessments:

- Reading, Writing, Maths (≥EXS): 83.3% (2023/24) vs 75.0% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 62.7%
- GDS/High Score: 15.0% (2023/24) vs 10.9% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 9.7%
- Reading (≥Exp.Std.): 90.0% (2023/24) vs 84.4% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 76.5%
- Reading (High Score): 28.3% (2023/24) vs 46.9% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 34.1%
- Writing (≥EXS): 91.7% (2023/24) vs 79.7% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 72.4%

Impact on Outcomes:

Despite some decreases in attainment percentages, Rayleigh Primary School continues to perform significantly above Essex averages in all key areas. The increase in reading high scores and maths high scores is particularly noteworthy, demonstrating sustained excellence in these subjects.

- Reading High Scores: Increased from 28.3% to 46.9%, significantly above the Essex average of 34.1%
- Maths Performance: Continues to outperform Essex averages by 12.1% in expected standards and 11.1% in high scores



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North Crescent Primary School

- Cohort Size: Increased from 18 (2023/24) to 22 (2024/25)
- Male Students: Increased from 22.2% (2023/24) to 68.2% (2024/25)
- SEN Support: Data redacted,
- Ethnicity (BME): Increased from redacted to 9.1% (2024/25)
- Language (EAL): Increased from redacted to 18.2% (2024/25)

Attainment and Assessments:

- Reading, Writing, Maths (≥EXS): 72.2% (2023/24) vs 68.2% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 62.7%
- GDS/High Score: 5.6% (2023/24) vs 9.1% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 9.7%
- Reading (≥Exp.Std.): 77.8% (2023/24) vs 72.7% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 76.5%
- Reading (High Score): 44.4% (2023/24) vs 9.1% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 34.1%
- Writing (≥EXS): 72.2% (2023/24) vs 86.4% (2024/25)

Impact on Outcomes:

North Crescent Primary School maintains strong performance above Essex averages despite significant demographic changes. The writing performance is particularly strong, with 86.4% achieving expected standards compared to the Essex average of 72.4%.

- Writing Performance: 86.4% achieving expected standards, 14.0% above the Essex average
- Greater Depth in Writing: 18.2% achieving GDS, 3.4% above Essex average

Wyburns Primary School

- Cohort Size: Increased from 30 (2023/24) to 31 (2024/25)
- Male Students: Decreased from 66.7% (2023/24) to 58.1% (2024/25)
- SEN Support: Increased from 6.7% (2023/24) to 19.4% (2024/25)
- Ethnicity (BME): redacted
- Language (EAL): Increased from redacted to 6.5% (2024/25)

Attainment and Assessments:

- Reading, Writing, Maths (≥EXS): 73.3% (2023/24) vs 45.2% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 62.7%
- GDS/High Score: 6.7% (2023/24) vs 3.2% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 9.7%
- Reading (≥Exp.Std.): 93.3% (2023/24) vs 77.4% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 76.5%
- Reading (High Score): 40.0% (2023/24) vs 29.0% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 34.1%
- Writing (≥EXS): 83.3% (2023/24) vs 58.1% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 72.4%
- Writing (GDS): 13.3% (2023/24) vs 3.2% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 14.8%
- Maths (≥Exp.Std.): 80.0% (2023/24) vs 58.1% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 75.4%
- Maths (High Score): 30.0% (2023/24) vs 22.6% (2024/25)
 - Essex Average: 26.4%

Impact on Outcomes:

Wyburns Primary School has seen some decreases in attainment this year, which may be attributed to the significant increase in SEN support needs and changes in cohort demographics. However, reading performance remains strong at 77.4% achieving expected standards.

- Writing Attainment: Needs targeted intervention as attainment has decreased significantly
- Maths Performance: Requires review as both expected standards and high scores have decreased

Combined Analysis

- Rayleigh Primary School: Continues to excel in maths and reading high scores, maintaining significantly above-average performance
- North Crescent Primary School: Shows exceptional writing performance and maintains strong results despite demographic challenges
- Wyburns Primary School: While facing challenges, maintains reading performance above Essex averages

Moving Forward:

1. Targeted interventions in writing and maths at Wyburns Primary School
2. Maintaining excellence in reading and maths at Rayleigh Primary School
3. Supporting North Crescent Primary School to sustain its writing achievements
4. Continued professional development for all staff to address changing student needs

Pupil Premium (FSM6) Performance

Summary 2024/25

Across our Multi Academy Trust, Pupil Premium students demonstrate strong outcomes in core subjects, with mixed performance against Essex averages.

Key Achievements:

Rayleigh Primary School:

- 53.3% met expected standards in Reading, Writing & Maths (vs. Essex 43.7%).
- 73.3% achieved expected standards in Maths (vs. Essex 58.1%).
- 66.7% met expected standards in Reading (vs. Essex 62.5%).
- 20.0% achieved Greater Depth (GDS) in Writing (vs. Essex 6.3%).



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North Crescent Primary School:

- 55.6% met expected standards in RWM (vs. Essex 43.7%).
- 77.8% achieved expected standards in Writing (vs. Essex 56.1%).
- 66.7% met expected standards in Maths (vs. Essex 58.1%).

Wyburns Primary School:

- 50.0% met expected standards in RWM (vs. Essex 43.7%).
- 62.5% achieved expected standards in Writing (vs. Essex 56.1%).
- 100.0% of pupils reached High Score in Writing (vs. Essex 62.5%).

Areas for Development:

- Wyburns: Increase Greater Depth (GDS) attainment in Maths (currently 12.5% vs. Essex 12.7%).
- North Crescent Reading PPG outcomes compared to Essex
- Rayleigh Reading GDS



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
