In the event that pupils are directed to complete learning at home, please click on the link provided and work through the lessons in the order shown.

The lessons are designed to be completed sequentially. On Day 1 of school closure, complete Lesson 1; on Day 2, complete Lesson 2, and so on.

Pupils should do four lessons a day: English, maths, PE and Foundation. We also encourage your child to read each day.

In the event of school closures for more than 2 days, we will notify you of how to get this work marked and receive feedback from your teacher.
