Have a real drive to learn about how democratic boards work and how British Values are shown.



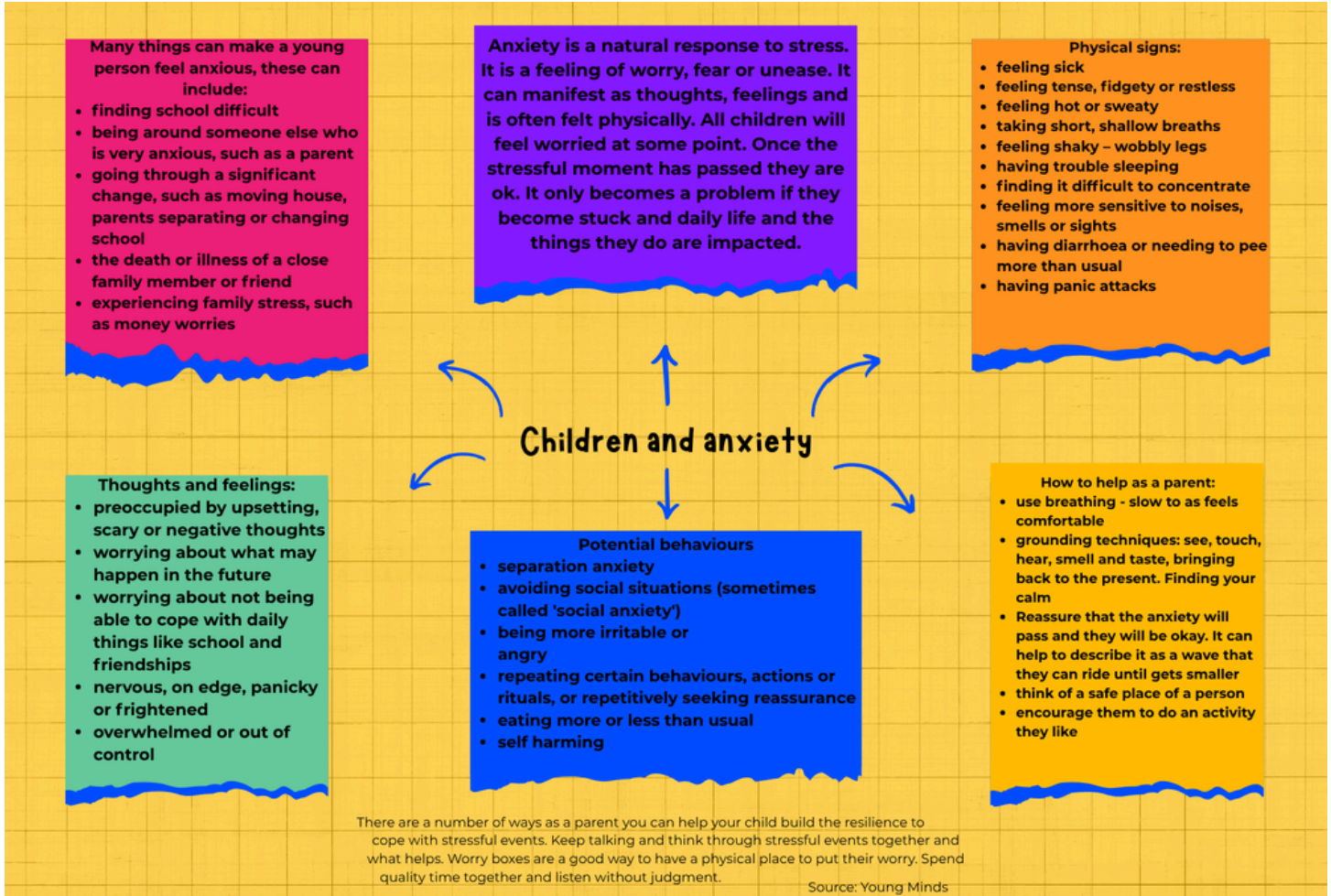
CEO REFLECTIONS
